## **Impromptu Guidelines**

Each speaker will choose one of three topics, which will be a word or a phrase – anything not related to current events. He or she will speak about one topic without the use of notes. Wit, humor, philosophy, sentiment or absurdity are all equally welcome. Judges will be looking for some agility of thought and, above all, for the ability to communicate with style and originality.

Each speaker will have **two minutes** to prepare. Speakers may not consult any outside sources as they prepare. While speakers may write notes as they prepare, they cannot use those notes when they speak.

Each speaker will speak for **three to five minutes**. A time penalty will be assessed for going over five minutes or under three minutes (there is a fifteen second grace period). Speeches outside the grade period will be assessed a **ten-point** penalty.

Judges should assign a score to each speech. While the scoresheet includes categories to help judges evaluate the speeches, the only score that matters is the final score (**TOTAL POINTS**). This should be a whole number between 70 and 95. Do **not** deduct a penalty when you write your score; penalties will be assessed in the tabulation room.

The four speakers in each room should also receive a **Rank in Room** score. Please rank the speakers, one through four, with one being the **best** speaker in the room. There cannot be ties in Rank in Room. Even if speakers have the same number of speaker points, you need to make a distinction in rank.
